INSTRUCTIONS:

Make a background on stiff cardboard or masonite board, blue sky, green grass, house, and tree. This will be the back page of a book. Drill holes on side and insert rings. Make eight cardboard pages just large enough to glue the eight figures of boy Jesus onto each page in the order of the activities of the song. Insert rings and turn each picture page as song is sung. (Make cardboard pages small enough so that they do not completely


